Status as missionary appointee

Upon appointment by MCE, the individual is eligible to begin assembling a support team for prayer and finance. All venues and benefits will be available to the appointee to assist in this task (web page access, email networking, US mail, prayer cards & literature, etc.).

Orientation curriculum

A curriculum syllabus is provided to residents. Each residency schedule will be constructed prior to placement at the residency site.

Regular onsite / online meetings

Required meetings with MCE leadership will take place on a regular basis. Notification of such meetings will be made well in advance.

Field determination

Successful completion of the residency will include the determination of a church planting target field in which the resident will be placed. Roles within target fields are varied and will be established in cooperation with MCE leadership according to the appointee's giftedness, readiness, consent, and other relevant factors.

Residency Site Ministry / Network Component:

A supportive relational environment toward IFCA International and agreement to permit participation by residents in IFCA International Regional and annual events wherever possible.

Reasonable potential base of operation for an MCE church plant or replant

The residency site will work cooperatively with MCE in determining potential church planting target fields. Principles and strategies for targeting fields are part of the residency curriculum.

Local ministry profile.

The MCE residency program is designed with the intent of providing benefit for both the local church ministry and for the MCE resident.

- The residency site ministry should expect to reap spiritual fruit in the Great Commission areas of outreach and discipleship, as well as to have the inherent help that comes with quality ministry labor performed by the resident.
- The MCE resident should expect to gain valuable exposure and experience to a variety of ministry functions within local churches. Special attention will be given to the six vital skills emphasized in the curriculum: *teaching, outreach, leadership, communication, planning, teamwork.*
